DECIDUOUS TREES:

ACERS/MAPLES Find photos of these MAPLES by going to a search engine and type in the name followed by the word 'photo'. Japanese Maples make good companions for rhododendrons and azaleas as they prefer well drained, aerated and slightly acid soil and partial shade; perfect for our west coast! Height shown is at maturity. Most J. Maples are suitable for growing in a pot. The # refers to pot size. i.e - #1 being a 1 gallon pot). J.Maples are generally **deer resistant**.

Rhodos are generally deer resistant, need well drained soil with a porous soil mix (about 1/3 course bark mulch mixed in). Rhododendrons, azaleas, Japanese Maples and Magnolias make great garden companions. Azaleas are rhododendrons, however, they are listed under deciduous shrubs. Rhodos are **generally deer resistant**.

Dwarf (about 10'), Semi-Dwarf (about 21 – 15'), Standard (about 15 – 20 feet) . All fruit trees respond well to significant pruning & will produce more as a result! ** Indicates a polinator is required. Plant peaches & nectarines under an eave on the south side of a building to minimize peach leaf curl. Fruit trees are not deer resistant and will need protection.
